

History of CISP education intervention

1983	CISP starts its activities in Somalia with health interventions in Middle Juba
1992	CISP supported primary schools in Mogadishu, with literacy programs, training for teachers and distribution of kits
1995 1997	CISP supported primary and nomadic schools in Ceel Dheer and Xarardere districts
1998 2000	CISP supported primary, koranic and nomadic schools in Ceel Dheer and Xarardere districts
2000 2003	CISP supported primary, koranic and nomadic schools Ceel Dheer, Xarardere and El Buar districts (approximately 20 schools)
2003 2007	- CISP supported District Education Boards, Community Education Committees and Diaspora groups in strengthening the education system and establishing community learning centers in Galgaduud - From 2005 CISP supported 27 primary schools in rural areas in Puntland.
2008 2010	- CISP supported more than 40 schools in 25 rural locations in Galgaduud and South Mudug - 2009: Functional literacy and vocational training programme started in Galgaduud, South Mudug and Hirran regions
2011	CISP is supporting 39 mixed schools and 9 schools in IDP camps in Galgaduud and South Mudug, with attention to gender equity, inclusion of IDPs and child protection
