## **Rights**

Access to clean water is essential for life and the dignity of people. Contaminated water is a cause for health problems.

## **Action:**

- Construction and rehabilitation of water points, shallow wells, boreholes and water storage facilities
- Treatment of water;
- Establishment and training of Community Water and Sanitation Committees, to take charge of water points
- Construction of water points through cash for work programs;
- Rehabilitation and construction of sanitation facilities (latrines and hand washing points), separate for men and women
- Provision of pipelines and storage tanks in urban areas hosting IDPs;
- Hygiene promotion in schools and health facilities.

## **People reached:**

In 2012 the following was achieved;

- 3,150 women and girls and 1,350 men and boys were reached through a hygiene promotion campaign
- From 2013, 13,000 women and girls and 12,500 men and boys will be able to access water and hygiene facilities

- Galgaduud: Dhuusamarreeb and Ceel Dheer;
- Mudug: Hobyo and Xarardheere;
- Banadir: Mogadishu.
