In 2012 the following benefited from CISP's Health Program:

- 18 Maternal and Child Health (MCH) centers were supported;
- 115,736 patients were seen, including 59,163 children below 5 years;
- 45,396 children aged between 6 to 59 months were screened for malnutrition;
- 3,356 children aged between 6 to 59 months were successfully treated for Severe Acute Malnutriti
- 57,235 children below 5 years were immunized;
- 2,617 births were assisted by skilled health workers;
- 32,912 pregnant women received antenatal care;
- 12,888 women were seen at the postnatal care clinics;
- 1,006 women were referred to hospitals for pregnancy related complications.
