BACKGROUND ON CISP HEALTH AND NUTRITION PROGRAM

Comitato Internazionale Per Lo Sviluppo Dei Popoli – CISP (International Committee for the Development of Peoples) is a development organization established in Rome in 1983, to engage against the impact of poverty and denied rights worldwide. CISP considers the community's needs as a whole and adopts a comprehensive approach towards them, providing a range of interventions tailored to the context. So far, main Geographic Areas of intervention in Kenya have been the coast of Kenya, Nairobi, Kajiado, and Nakuru. CISP's priority Sectors of Intervention includes: Education, Health and Nutrition, Livelihood, Child Protection and devolution. "Improving the health and nutrition status of mother and child in Kajiado" is a project initiated in March 2014 in partnership with world Friends and the Kajiado County Government. The overall objective of the project is to improve the mother and child health status, increase MCH and nutrition services in among the community in Kajiado. In particular Kajiado County health stakeholders' forum co-ordination is key in achieving this objective. CISP is taking a lead role in supporting the co-ordination of the stakeholders' forum

This intervention will address three main areas:

- 1. Quarterly meeting of the County stakeholders' forums
- 2. Training of members of stakeholders' forum on planning, implementing and monitoring of common activities
- 3. Development of health stakeholders' web page

1. Consultancy Purpose

The Web Designer will develop the County health stakeholders' web page in English.

The web page is expected to be of modern, simple and practical design, user-friendly, with smooth navigation, good information resource and working tool for the all the partners, stakeholders and general public in Kajiado, Kenya and abroad. Since it will be linked to the main County website, there will be improvement of the general County website as well.

2. Description of Work and Timeline:

The implementation of the work should be under supervision and guidance of the Technical assistant and shared with all the stakeholders involved in the project before approval. The description and timeline for the work to be performed will be the following:

3. Technical note:

The "Kajiado County Health stakeholders' web page should be of modern design, with simple and user-friendly interface and menu. Smooth navigation should be ensured also with slow and unreliable internet

connection like in Kajiado. Usability is one of the most important aspects. The website should be compatible with most of Web browsers, particularly with Internet Explorer (starting from v.6.0), Mozilla Firefox (starting from v.2.0). It should also be compatible with various screen sizes and resolutions.

4. Required Qualifications:

The web developer should have:

- University Degree or diploma in Graphic/web design, communication or relevant field.
- Advance knowledge of the modern web development technologies, HTML, ASP, PHP, SQL, JavaScript, knowledge of web design.
- Good knowledge Dreamweaver, Photoshop, Flash, Illustrator.
- At least 5 years relevant work experience in Web and graphic design (experience with international organization is an asset)
- Proven experience in web development field, graphic design and communication, solid portfolio of accomplished web projects (applicant has to present at least 3 Web Sites developed).
- Good communication skills.
- Fluency in English.
